The Bournemouth Town Centre Survey was launched at the start of the month and the feedback has been really positive with well over 2,000 responses already. Ideas and feedback shared through the survey will have a real impact on decisions in the months and years ahead and will be taken to a Town Centre Summit in the autumn where an exciting, vibrant, attractive future for Bournemouth town centre will be mapped out and taken forward.

Cllr Marcus Andrews, who as a Chartered Surveyor has dealt with a whole range of properties over many years in Bournemouth Town centre for both landlords and tenants, says: "All town centres across the UK are evolving as residents and visitors change their shopping habits. We can learn from other towns who have succeeded in bringing back vitality and interest into their centres. Landlords of commercial units want their tenants to succeed and draw in more custom."
